Minutes: Liz moved we accept the April 12 minutes as amended. Bob seconded. Passed unanimously.

Visitors: Dennis Graham visited us to discuss the lease renewal for the A-frame house on 135 Old Ashby Rd., Mason. We discussed the current state of the electrical wiring. We reviewed the current Lease Agreement of July 7 2019. We reviewed Dennis' document Planned Projects and Maintenance of June 3, 2019. As a result of our discussion, we agreed to (i) have the roof inspected, (ii) have the fireplace inspected, (iii) let Dennis install a water filter, (iv) let Dennis put in a sump pump, and (v) let Dennis determine whether a tall pine near the house might hit the house if it fell. We agreed to discuss the rental price further after getting more information from Dennis.
