Selectmen / FD Staff Meeting 8/23/2022 Approved Minutes

<u>Present:</u> Selectmen Kate Batcheller, Charlie Moser, John Suiter (via Zoom); Admin Asst Jen Tenney; Fire Chief Tony Burns; Accountant Brenda Wiley

<u>Called to Order:</u> The meeting was called to order at 7:03pm by Chair Kate Batcheller, attendance was taken by roll call as reflected above

Meeting Discussion:

- Budget
 - o Line item 4220-02 (Volunteers Per Diem Pay)
 - This line item was discussed as it is projecting to be over budget by \$3-\$4k at the end of the year. Chief Burns discussed being able to take funds from line item 4220-10, 4220-11 and 4220-50, along with \$1000 of unused funds from line item 4220-21 to cover the over budget amount.
 - o For 2023 budget, Chief Burns will create a separate line item for training as that is the only part of volunteer wages that can be budgeted for.
- Waterhole Maintenance Chief Burns currently needs to spend a lot of time dredging in order to maintain and is considering switching to dry hydrants in the future. Chief Burns would come up with a multiple year plan, along with considering Warrant Articles, to achieve switching to dry hydrants.
- The command vehicle is well on its way
- Engine 3 sale waiting on payment to go through to continue process
- Chief Burns will sign up as the Public Health Representative for the Town of Mason as part of his EMD duties
- The station pump issue is being worked on, waiting on well pump
- The Milford Fire Department is gifting the Town of Mason 24 communication radios
- Emergency Operation Plan no new update
- The Mason Energy Commission monitors are in place and working

Adjournment: There being no further business, Kate motioned to adjourn, second from Charlie. Roll call vote Kate-aye, Charlie-aye, John-aye. Meeting adjourned at 7:39pm.
